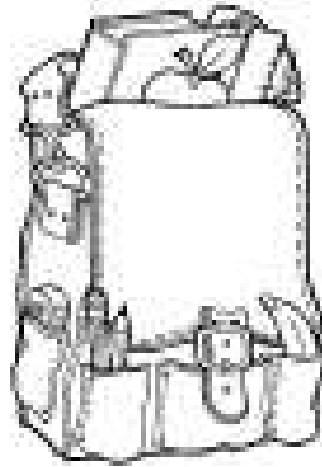

### **Mt. Olivet Preschool**

## 2-Year-Old Class

In the two year old class, children are taught to interact socially with an emphasis placed on being a good friend, taking turns, and sharing. Teachers facilitate age appropriate learning activities and students complete simple craft projects. Children attend two days per week and potty training is not required.

This class is limited to 6 children. **The class meets 2 days per week (Tues. & Wed.) with monthly tuition of \$110 per child.**

## 3-Year-Old Class

In the three year old class, children adapt to a structured learning environment. Teachers emphasize social and language development, reading and math readiness, and attention to both fine and gross motor skills. Play and craft activities support imaginative and interpersonal development. Children must be potty trained.

This class is limited to 9 children. **The class meets three days per week (Tues.-Thurs.), and monthly tuition is \$135.**

Two and three year old student interact and share during the unstructured play portion of their school day.

## 4-Year-Old Class

The four-year-old class prepares children for a successful transition into kindergarten. Instruction focuses on students recognizing and writing their own name, learning the alphabet, basic math concepts, and reading readiness. Basic reading skills are taught using the preschool version of the Open Court Reading Program. The social skills of getting along with peers and forming friendships are encouraged and reinforced. Children play together, participate in a wide range of art activities, explore science topics, learn songs and see their work displayed. Class size is limited to 12 students. **This class meets three days per week (Tues.-Thurs.), and monthly tuition is \$135 per child.**

## Preschool Staff

All classroom teachers are certified as early childhood teachers. Teachers engage students in a variety of educational and recreational activities, assist children in checking out books from the school library cart, and plan various enrichment activities.

The preschool administrator oversees the program and serves as a link between the school and the Church. A Preschool Board oversees the workings of the preschool and sets school policies.

## Register Now!
